


Tropical Storms Ana & Bill





Hazardous Weather Outlook

> **Riverside Rd, between Bennett Rd and Erect Rd—CLOSED with detour** for bridge replacement.



D-0 Abnormally Dry




D-0 = Abnormally Dry Conditions

Buses Hit the Roads

On Tuesday, August 25 school buses will again hit the roads of Randolph County.



1 Two-lane roadway:
When school bus stops for passengers, all traffic from both directions must stop!

2 Two-lane roadway with a center turning lane:
When school bus stops for passengers, all traffic from both directions must stop!

3 Four-lane roadway without a median separation:
When school bus stops for passengers, all traffic from both directions must stop!

4 Divided highway of four lanes or more with a median separation:
When school bus stops for passengers, only traffic following the bus must stop.

5 Roadway of four lanes or more with a center turning lane:
When school bus stops for passengers, only traffic following the bus must stop.


